Dear Students,

Thank you very much for expressing interest in the CDFD's Research Scholars Program – II – 2017. On the basis of information provided in your application, I am happy to inform that you have been shortlisted to appear for the Computer (LAN) based examination, which will be held on 21.01.2018. Individual Admit Card / Hall Ticket with details of user name, password, **VENUE OF THE EXAMINATION AND TIME** may directly be downloaded from the individual online user account. In case of any difficulty in downloading the hall-ticket, you may mail us to [academia@cdfd.org.in](mailto:academia@cdfd.org.in) for arranging the hall-tickets through e-mail.

You are requested to report directly to the Examination Centre one hour before the examination time slot mentioned in your Admit Card / Hall Ticket. You are also requested to bring the following documents in original for verification:

- i. Proof of passing the Master's degree in any branch of Science, Technology, or Agriculture from a recognized University/ Institute or M.B.B.S Post Graduate examination.
- ii. Proof of clearing Qualified CSIR / UGC / DBT / ICMR / INSPIRE NET JRF / UGC – RGNF (or similar) or have qualified BINC examination conducted by the DBT with fellowship or JEST with a valid fellowship i.e., the fellowship should be valid to be activated from 01.01.2018. If the NET qualifying certificate is not available, Hall ticket should be produced. Candidates having qualified for the Project – JRF fellowship under the ICMR funded project Scheme/ [which is only for a period of two years] / DBT JRF NET with a B.Tech. [Biotechnology] degree /DBT JRF NET under DBT – B category list are NOT eligible to apply
- iii. Proof of your Date of Birth and Reservation category (if applicable).
- iv. Proof of Photo Identity (like Driving License, Voter ID Card, etc.) .

Admit Card / Hall Tickets will not be sent through postal mode. If the Hall Ticket is not received by 10.01.2018, you may also contact the Academics Section of the CDFD at the following Telephone numbers for providing copy of the Hall Ticket.

There would be one hour test comprising of 60 questions.

**GUIDELINES FOR SPOT REGISTRATION:**

The following candidates may also appear for the entrance examination under **SPOT REGISTRATION CATEGORY** subject to production of valid proof in original, supporting all the essential qualifications like M.Sc., MBBS or NET qualification, caste certificate (if applicable), photo identity etc.

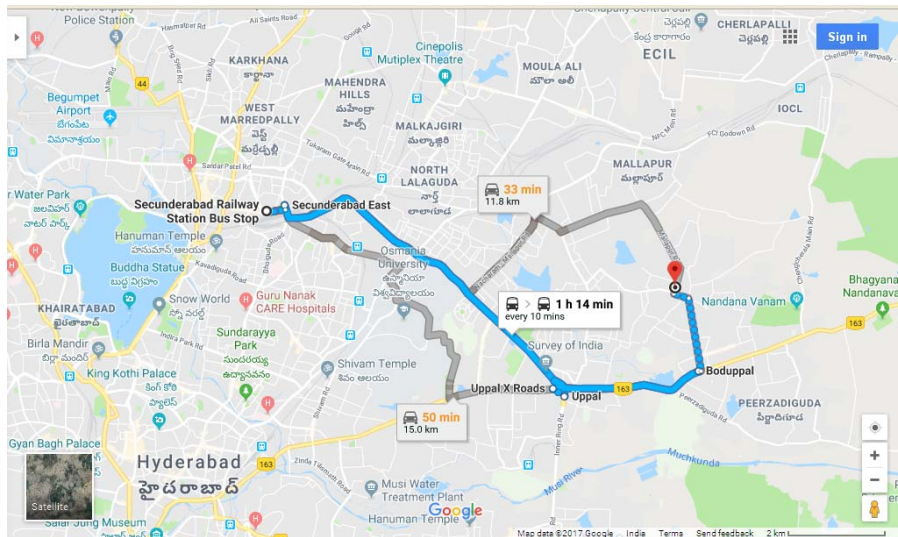
- i) Candidates who have not applied earlier for the RSP – II – 2017 program, but have requisite qualifications and valid fellowship.
- ii) Candidates who have already applied but could not find their name in the shortlisted list because of incomplete information/non payment of Application fees.

Candidates who wish to register under SPOT REGISTRATION CATEGORY should report to the following examination centre on 21.01.2018 at 08.00 A.M. with all the required documents (in original) along with two recent passport size photographs for completing the formalities/verification of documents. The candidates registering under “SPOT REGISTRATION CATEGORY” are requested to pay the requisite fee as given below in the form of cash:

Names of the candidates who successfully qualify in the entrance examination will be displayed on our website, as well as on our notice boards by 6.00 p.m. on 21.01.2018. The successful candidates are required to attend the personal interview on 22.01.2018 from 8.00 a.m. onwards at the CDFD.

No TA/DA will be paid for attending the Computer (LAN) based examination / interview.

It is also to inform that applicants to CDFD's JRF program who clear the LAN exam on January 21 and then get shortlisted following the interviews on January 22 will be given the opportunity to visit CDFD on January 23, 2017 to meet with CDFD faculty to familiarize themselves with the faculty's research interests.

Due to constraints of space and time this option can be extended only to the candidates who are shortlisted after the **first interview**. These candidates would be asked to stay back for the second shorter interview by the second committee. The Shortlisted candidates may contact individual faculty members via email or phone (email addresses and phone numbers are available on the CDFD website) to try and fix mutually convenient meeting times.

Contacting the faculty is purely optional. You may contact them by email or phone as well. If you are shortlisted on January 22, but are unable to stay on in Hyderabad on January 23, it will not be held against you. The purpose of these meetings is merely to give shortlisted candidates (and the faculty) an opportunity to acquaint themselves with each other.

Conversely, even if you are shortlisted and choose to stay on in Hyderabad to meet faculty on January 23, the CDFD will not be obliged to select you for a JRF position. The JRF selections will be made from the shortlist, but the selection criteria will be independent of whether or not a candidate has stayed back to meet faculty.
